✓ Attach a copy of your U. S. birth certificate, Baptismal certificate or U. S. Passport.

Citizen not born in United States-

✓ Bring in form FS-240 bearing the embossed seal including the words “United States of America” and “State Department”(we will make a copy); or

✓ Your Certificate of Citizenship (we will make a copy) ; or

✓ Your Certificate of Naturalization (we will make a copy) ; or

✓ A copy of your U. S. Passport

Non-citizen Nationals (natives of American Samoa or Swain’s Island) - Permanent residents of the Northern Mariana Islands or the Trust Territory of Pacific Islands -

✓ Attach a copy of your U. S. Birth certificate or U. S. passport.

✓ Attach copies of both sides of your Alien Registration Receipt card (I-551, I-151 or _-551C); or

✓ A copy of your passport, valid through first day of classes, stamped “Processed for I-551..” showing copy of the picture Identification page); or

✓ Copy of your Departure Record (Form I-94) valid through the first day of classes, stamped “processed for I-151.....” showing the expiration date, or stamped “Temporary Firm I-551” showing the expiration date. Include copy of the picture identification page.

- ✓ Attach copy of your “Arrival-Departure Record” (Form I-94) with a stamp indicating one of the following:
 - Refugee, Asylum Granted, Indefinite Parole and/or Humanitarian Parole, Cuban Haitian entrant – Status pending; or
- ✓ A copy of both sides of a current form I-688 “Temporary Resident Card”; or
- ✓ A copy of a court order or INS letter confirming suspension of deportation.

□ **NOTE: You are not eligible to receive Student Aid if you are:**

- ✓ An applicant for permanent resident status and not in a category listed above;
- ✓ A student with an F1 or F (Student Visa), J1 or J2 (exchange visitor) or L or G series Visa; or
- ✓ A student with only a Card I-688 A (Employment Authorization) or only a Card I-688B (Employment Authorization); or
- ✓ An applicant under the “Voluntary Departure Under the Family Unity Program”; or
- ✓ Undocumented
