FERPA

What is FERPA?

The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, sets forth requirements regarding the privacy of student records. FERPA governs: (1) release of these records (known as education records) maintained by an educational institution and (2) access to these records. This law applies to K-12 as well as postsecondary education.

Basically:

1. College students must be permitted to inspect their educational records.
2. School officials may not disclose personally identifiable information about students nor permit inspection of their records without written permission unless such action is covered by certain exceptions permitted by the act.

Your rights as a student:

- Right to inspect and review education records.
- Right to request to amend education records.
- Right to limit disclosure of some "personally identifiable information" (information that would directly identify the student or make the student's identity easily traceable) known as *directory information*.

What it means:

Financial aid information will not be released by phone or email unless this written request has been completed and submitted to the Financial Aid Office. Please check the appropriate box (below) and sign where indicated.
