

# – CHANGES – to Financial Aid Regulations and Processes 2018-2019

changes

1. Maximum Pell Grant will remain at \$6,095
2. Maximum Pell Grant EFC will remain at \$5328
3. Cash Course and iGrad, an online money management tool, is available on [financialaid.fullcoll.edu](http://financialaid.fullcoll.edu)
4. Starting Summer 2018, students may be eligible for additional Pell Grant funds through Year Round Pell.
5. 2018/2019 FAFSA available beginning October 1, 2017. Students will need to use the 2016 tax information.
6. Beginning with the 2018/2019 academic year, the Board of Governor Fee Waiver (BOG-FW) will be called California College Promise Grant. All other program requirements remain unchanged.
7. Students can now get their disbursement faster by logging into myGateway to complete the Bank Mobile refund selection process. No need for a separate log-in.
8. Dream Act students will now have the ability to use the Student Verification website to upload documentation (California College Promise Grant Appeal, SAP Appeals, FERPA and Verification).
9. Loan request applications will be part of the [verifymyfafsa](http://verifymyfafsa) student portal and will be submitted on-line.
10. Students selected for verification or who have other outstanding requirements will find one option in myGateway, and a more streamlined step-by-step process for 18/19.
11. The IRS Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) is operational again for 18/19 FAFSA. We encourage you (and your parent, if dependent) to take advantage of this tool to simplify the application process and completion of your Financial Aid File, the follow-up process, as well as to streamline completion of the FAFSA.
12. Mobile App for FAFSA will be operational in 2018.
