Financial Aid Workshops are offered by the Fullerton College Financial Aid Office to allow students to “drop in” with their questions, complete a FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application, get help on verification, and gain information on the financial aid process.

If you are filing a 2019/2020 FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application, you will need your 2017 tax information.

If you are filing a 2020/2021 FAFSA or CA Dream Act Application, you will need your 2018 tax information.

The following documents are needed in order to complete the application online:

- Your Social Security Card and Driver’s License/State Identification Card.
- Your Alien Registration Card (if you are not a U.S. Citizen).
- Your 2017/2018 Federal income tax return and/or W2 forms (include parent’s tax information if dependent).
- Parent’s Social Security Number, Date of Birth and Date of Marital Status (if dependent).

NOTE: If you do not come prepared with the required documents in order to complete your application, the Financial Aid staff can only provide guidance on the FAFSA/CA Dream Act Application. Please make child care arrangements in advance as children cannot be allowed in the classroom.
