### Come Prepared – Information & Instructions

The Financial Aid Office is currently closed for in-person services, including in-person assistance with completing financial aid applications – Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and California Dream Act Application (CADAA). Instead, we will be providing assistance via Zoom on the step-by-step process of completing your FAFSA or CADAA.

The workshops will only be for guidance on completing your FAFSA or CADAA. If you need more in-depth assistance that requires us to look into your specific account, please contact your assigned Financial Aid Technician via email, text message, or phone. **If you are interested in attending the workshop for step-by-step guidance on completing your FAFSA or CADAA, you must reserve your spot by sending an email to [faoutreach@fullcoll.edu](mailto:faoutreach@fullcoll.edu).** You must send an email to attend the workshop, as attendance will be limited to 15 students. If the workshop is full, you may send an email for the next session.

The following documents are needed in order to complete the application online:

- Your Social Security Card or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) (If applicable)
- FSA ID or User ID and Password to complete your application
- Driver's License/State Identification Card (If applicable)
- Your Alien Registration Card (if you are not a U.S. Citizen) (If applicable)
- Your 2019 Federal income tax return and/or W2 forms (include parent's tax information if dependent) (If applicable)
- Parent's Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) (If applicable)
- Parent's full name, date of birth and date of marital status (if dependent)

NOTE: If you do not have the required documents listed above, the Financial Aid Technician will only be able to provide general information about the financial aid application process. Completion of application will not occur without required documents.
