STEP 1

Apply for financial aid by completing the FAFSA at https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa *OR* the California Dream Act Application (CADAA) at https://dream.csac.ca.gov/ by the priority deadline of March 2nd. The Fullerton College school code is 001201.

STEP 2

Carefully review the information provided on your FAFSA Submission Summary (FSS).

Your FSS will provide basic estimates about your eligibility for student aid, but it is not a financial aid offer. Students may access their FSS on their StudentAid.gov dashboard.

STEP 3

Complete any additional requirements by the priority deadline of May 30th.

Login to myGateway > select Student Tools> select Financial Aid > select My Overall Status > select the correct academic year. Any outstanding requirements you may have will be listed here. Most requirements will be satisfied on your Student Forms account (https://fullcoll.studentforms.com).

STEP 4 Set-up your financial aid refund preference on myGateway.
