

# 5 EASY STEPS TO FINANCIAL AID

# 1

To apply for financial aid, complete the **FAFSA** at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov) or the **CA Dream Act Application (CADAA)** at [dream.csac.ca.gov](http://dream.csac.ca.gov), whichever is applicable to the student (only one application should be submitted).

Students can receive in-person help at the Financial Aid Computer Lab during regular business hours. Remember, the state priority filing deadline is **April 2, 2025**, and the **Fullerton College school code is 001201**.

# 2

Thoroughly examine the details presented in your **FAFSA Submission Summary** or **CADAA Submission Summary**. This summary will give you initial estimates regarding your eligibility for student aid, but keep in mind that it does not constitute a financial aid offer. Students can access their application submission summary on the website where they applied for financial aid.

# 3

Complete any additional financial aid requirements by the priority deadline of **May 30, 2025**. Most requirements will be satisfied on your **Student Forms account** at [fullcoll.studentforms.com](http://fullcoll.studentforms.com).

**Navigation:** Go to myGateway > select Student Tools > select Financial Aid > Review information under Unsatisfied Requirements for the current school year.

Set-up your financial aid refund preference on myGateway. Our school delivers your refund with **BankMobile Disbursements**, a technology solution, powered by BMTX, Inc. Disbursement dates are available on the How Financial Aid Gets to You flyer found on the Financial Aid website.

**Navigation:** Go to myGateway > select Student Tools > select BankMobile.

Be prepared to cover the costs of textbooks, supplies, and other fees upfront. Keep in mind that financial aid, apart from the **California College Promise Grant (CCPG)**, will not be accessible to students until after the school year starts.
