California Dream Act Service Incentive Grant Program

Financial Aid

The California Dream Act Service Incentive Grant Program (DSIG) supports CADAA students with Cal Grant A or B awards by encouraging community or volunteer service. Eligible students can receive up to \$4,500 per academic year (\$2,250 per semester) for up to 8 semesters while maintaining an active Cal Grant. Annual applications are required to participate in DSIG.

DSIG Eligibility

To qualify, you must:

- Complete the California Dream Act Application (CADAA) for the year.
- Be an active recipient of a Cal Grant A or B Award.
- Demonstrate sufficient financial need per CSAC or Financial Aid Office.
- Meet Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) as determined by the Financial Aid Office.

Apply, Perform, & Request Payment

To apply for the DSIG program, students must:

1. Submit the DSIG application:

- Email it to CSAC at studentsupport@csac.ca.gov.
- Ensure the Financial Aid Office completes Section 2: School of Attendance Information, validating unmet need.
- 2. Complete community service:
 - Perform 150 hours per semester at an eligible organization, using the CSAC website's List of Service Organizations for guidance.
- 3. Request payment:
 - Submit the Payment Request form via email to CSAC after fulfilling all requirements, ensuring the Financial Aid Office completes necessary validation beforehand.
